**Sacrament of Reconciliation -** Congratulations to our year 4 children who celebrated the Sacrament of Reconciliation by making their First Confession, on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> December at St Francis of Assisi Church. Thank you to our teachers, catechists, priests, parents/carers and pupils for making this so special.

**Key Stage 2 Advent Masses –** Our key stage 2 children have recently attended Advent Masses with Holy Trinity School. This was a very reverent occasion. Thank you to all the parents/carers who were able to walk the children to Church.

Year 4 Nativity – Many thanks to the parents/carers who attended the year 4 Nativity this week. This was a lovely performance by our children, and we hope you all enjoyed it! Well done to all!

**Safeguarding –** It has been brought to my attention by several year 5 and 6 parents/carers that boys in particular, are accessing a website that contains 'chat up lines' which are called '*rizzies*'. These chat up lines can be found on You Tube, TikTok and men's lifestyle websites. These chat up lines are of a sexual and misogynistic nature. Some of these 'rizzies' have been used in school towards our year 5 and 6 girls, which is totally unacceptable. I have spoken to all year 5 and 6 boys today as to the severity of this inappropriate sexualised language and I ask for parents/carers support in checking your child's devices, WhatsApp, Messenger etc..to ensure the safety of all of our children.

**On line safety -** With Christmas nearly upon us and many children either receiving new devices (or simply spending more time on them over the holidays), we have some advice for parents/carers before the holidays begin.
